AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE INNIS ARDEN CLUB, INC.

In furtherance of the foregoing purposes, this corporation shall have the following powers as implemented through Bylaws:

- (c) To solicit, collect, receive, acquire, hold and invest money in property, both real and personal, including money and property received by gift, contribution, bequest, or devise; to sell and convert property, both real and personal, into cash; and to use the funds of this corporation and the proceeds, income, rents, issues, and profits derived from any property of this corporation for any of the purposes for which this corporation is formed.
- (d) To purchase, acquire, own, hold, sell, assign, transfer, dispose of, mortgage, pledge, hypothecate, or encumber and to deal in shares, bonds, notes, debentures, or other securities or evidences of indebtedness of any person, firm, corporation, or association and while the owner or holder of them, to exercise all rights, powers and privileges or ownership.

- (e) To purchase and acquire, own, hold, use, lease (either as lessor or lessee), sell, exchange, assign, convey, dispose of, mortgage, hypothecate or encumber real and personal property.
- (f) To borrow money, incur indebtedness and to secure the repayment of the same by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust, or other hypothecation of property, both real and personal.
- (g) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose without limit or amount, with any persons, firm, association or corporation, municipality, county, parish, state, territory, government, or other municipal governmental subdivision.
- (h) To act as trustee under any trust incidental to the principal objects of the corporation and receive, hold, administer and expend funds and property subject to such trust.
- (I) To do all things necessary, expedient, or appropriate to accomplishment of any of the objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed.

RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE INNIS ARDEN CLUB

The undersigned, as President and Secretary of the above stated corporation, certify that the following articles have been approved in accordance with the terms and conditions of the articles and bylaws of the corporation and in accordance with the Washington Non-Profit Corporation Act, and do hereby adopt the Articles of Incorporation for such corporation set forth below.

These Restated Articles of Incorporation correctly set forth without change the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation as amended and the Restated Articles of Incorporation supersede the original Articles of Incorporation and all amendments thereto.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is: The Innis Arden Club, and its existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II

This corporation is organized for the following purposes:

(a) To operate and manage a Homeowners Association ("HOA") including an HOA as defined under RCW 64.38.010(11), and as it presently exists or may be amended;

(b) To, consistent with and in furtherance of the Innis Arden Restrictive Mutual Easements (Covenants) and Bylaws, establish, maintain, and operate a community club/homeowners association for the Innis Arden community and in connection therewith, to manage and protect Innis Arden property and assets, and engage in social, athletic, recreational, and community activities benefitting the Innis Arden community

ARTICLE III

In furtherance of the foregoing purposes, this corporation shall have the following powers as implemented through Bylaws:

- (a) To solicit, collect, receive, acquire, hold and invest money in property, both real and personal, including money and property received by gift, contribution, bequest, or devise; to sell and convert property, both real and personal, into cash; and to use the funds of this corporation and the proceeds, income, rents, issues, and profits derived from any property of this corporation for any of the purposes for which this corporation is formed.
- (b) To purchase, acquire, own, hold, sell, assign, transfer, dispose of, mortgage, pledge, hypothecate, or encumber and to deal in shares, bonds, notes, debentures, or other securities or evidences of indebtedness of any person, firm, corporation, or association and while the owner or holder of them, to exercise all rights, powers and privileges or ownership.
- (c) To purchase and acquire, own, hold, use, lease (either as lessor or lessee), sell, exchange, assign, convey, dispose of, mortgage, hypothecate or

encumber real and personal property.

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- (d) To borrow money, incur indebtedness and to secure the repayment of the same by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust, or other hypothecation of property, both real and personal.
- (e) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose without limit or amount, with any persons, firm, association or corporation, municipality, county, parish, state, territory, government, or other municipal governmental subdivision.
- (f) To act as trustee under any trust incidental to the principal objects of the corporation and receive, hold, administer and expend funds and property subject to such trust.
- (g) To do all things necessary, expedient, or appropriate to accomplishment of any of the objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed.
- (h) Notwithstanding any of the above statements, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are inconsistent with the primary purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation is organized pursuant to the general nonprofit corporation law of the State of Washington, and the property of this corporation is dedicated to the purposes of The Innis Arden Club, per the Innis Arden Restrictive Mutual Easements ("Covenants"). No part of the net income of this organization shall ever inure to the

benefit of any other organization or of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding-up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed as follows:

- (a) Assets held by the corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of the dissolution, shall be returned, transferred or conveyed in accordance with such requirements;
- (b) Assets received and held by the corporation subject to limitations permitting their use only for charitable, religious, eleemosynary, benevolent, educational or similar purposes, but not held upon a condition requiring return, transfer or conveyance by reason of the dissolution, shall be transferred or conveyed to one or more domestic or foreign corporations, societies or organizations engaged in activities substantially similar to those of the dissolving corporation, pursuant to a plan of distribution adopted as provided in this chapter;
- (c) Other assets, if any, shall be distributed to the Members in accordance with a plan of distribution adopted in accordance with Washington law.

ARTICLE V
